Alcohol Beverage Restriction

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (a), it is hereby ordered that the prohibitions hereinafter set forth apply to the Ocoee/Hiwassee District, within the Cherokee National Forest, shown on the attached map.

1. Possessing a beverage which is defined as an alcoholic beverage by State Law. 36 CFR 261.58(bb)



1. Persons with a special use permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission, issued by the District Ranger.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
