

# Zig Zag Trail #678



## Recreation Opportunity Guide

Distance..... 0.8 miles (one way)  
Elevation..... 2950-4000 feet  
Snow Free ..... May to October



**Trail Highlights:** This trail is on the east side of Mount Hood. The trail is short and lightly used.

**Trail Description:** This trail begins off Oregon Hwy 35 (2,950') and climbs to the junction with Dog River Trail #675 and Surveyor's Ridge Trail #688 (4,000').

### Regulations & Leave No Trace Information:

- Bikes are only allowed to ride uphill. No downhill riding to prevent erosion.

#### Leave No Trace

- Plan Ahead and Prepare: Prepare for extreme weather, hazards and emergencies.
- Travel and Camp on Durable Surfaces: Use established trails and campsites.
- Dispose of Waste Properly: Pack out all trash, leftover food and litter.
- Leave What You Find: Avoid introducing or transporting non-native species.
- Minimize Campfire Impacts: Use established fire rings & keep fires small.
- Respect Wildlife: Control pets at all times.
- Be Considerate of Other Visitors: Avoid loud voices and noises.



