USE OF VEHICLES OVER RESTRICTED BRIDGES

Pursuant to 16 United States Code (USC) § 551 and 36 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR.) § 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on all National Forest System lands within the Arapaho and Roosevelt National Forests in Larimer, Grand, Boulder, and Clear Creek Counties in the State of Colorado, here referred to as the Restricted Bridges. The roads listed in Attachment A and depicted as shown on the maps of Attachment B are hereby incorporated into this order. The purpose of this order is to protect public health and safety.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Operating a vehicle in violation of speed, load, weight, length, width limitations as posted on National Forest System Roads listed in Attachment A. 36 CFR § 261.54(d).

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from the specified Prohibitions of this order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit or authorization specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

This order will be in effect when signed and will remain in effect until rescinded.
