

**ORDER NO. 13-04**  
**WHITE FIRE AREA, ROAD AND TRAIL CLOSURE**  
**LOS PADRES NATIONAL FOREST**  
**SANTA BARBARA RANGER DISTRICT**

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited within the Santa Barbara Ranger District of the Los Padres National Forest. This Order is effective from June 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the White Fire Closure Area. The boundary of the White Fire Closure Area begins at the White Rock Day Use Area and continues west along the southern bank of the Santa Ynez River to its intersection with the Camuesa Connector Trailhead (Forest Trail No. 27W22), then continues north along the Camuesa Connector Trail to its intersection with Buckhorn Road (Forest Road No. 5N15), then continues southwest along Buckhorn Road to its intersection with the Upper Oso Campground, then continues west along the Aliso Trail (Forest Trail No. 28W05) to its intersection with the boundary of the White Fire burned area, then continues west along the boundary of the White Fire burned area to its intersection with the boundary of the Los Padres National Forest, then continues southwest along the forest boundary to its intersection with the boundary of the White Fire burned area, then continues south along the boundary of the White Fire burned area back to the starting point, as shown on Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.53(e).
2. Being on any National Forest System road within the White Fire Closure Area, as shown on Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.54(e).
3. Being on any National Forest System trail within the White Fire Closure Area, as shown on Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.55(a)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.




A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.
