**USDA FOREST SERVICE

Dillon RANGER DISTRICT**

**Occupancy and Use Restrictions
Breckenridge Peak 6 Trail and Lift Construction**

Pursuant to 16 United States Code (U.S.C.) § 551 and 36 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the described National Forest System (NFS) Lands located on the Dillon Ranger District of the White River National Forest in Summit County, State of Colorado, called Breckenridge Peak 6 Construction Area ("Restricted Area") and on all roads and trails within the Restricted Area (the "Restricted Roads and Trails").

The Restricted Area is further defined as all of National Forest System land between the western fork of the Green Gate Road in the vicinity of the 6th Principal Meridian, T6S, R78W, Section 26; to the Peak 6 ridgeline in the vicinity of the 6th Principal Meridian, T6S, R78W, Sections 27 & 28 and along the northern boundary of the Breckenridge operational boundary in the vicinity of the 6th Principal Meridian, T5N, R82W, Section 35. The Restricted Area and the Restricted Roads and Trails are shown on the attached map hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

This prohibition applies to wheeled motor vehicles and all other forms of motorized and non-motorized travel.

This Order is necessary to provide for public health and safety during the lift construction and felling and/or removal of trees from the project area during implementation of the *Breckenridge Peak 6 Project*.

PROHIBITIONS:

Being on the Restricted Roads. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54 (e).

Being on the Restricted Trails. 36 C.F.R. § 261.55(a).

Being in the Restricted Area. 36 C.F.R. § 261.53 (e).


EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:


- (1) Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission;
- (2) Holders of Forest Service special use authorizations and their authorized contractors, within the Restricted Area;
- (3) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and
- (4) Persons engaged in a business, trade, or occupation in the Restricted Area.

This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until rescinded or until May 1, 2014 whichever event occurs first.

Violation of this prohibition are punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559 and 3571.
