Forest Supervisor's Order**

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulation 261.50(b), the following act prohibits motor vehicle traffic, as described below, within the Nine-Mile Ranger District on the Lolo National Forest, Mineral County, P.M. Montana. This temporary closure is in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, and will become effective upon signing and will remain in effect until rescinded.

36 CFR 261.54 – National Forest System Roads:

It is prohibited to use any motorized vehicle upon the roads. (Title 36 CFR 261.54(a)).

The purpose of this order is to protect for public safety due to timber log yarding on or adjacent to these forest roads.

Description of Closed Roads:

Forest Development Roads (FDR) #4218 from the gate to the end, 34145 in its entirety, and 34356 in its entirety.

Roads are located in Sections 7, 8, 17, and 18, T. 12 N., R. 24 W.; Section 12, T. 12 N. R. 25 W. P.M. Montana.

THE ATTACHED VICINITY MAP HEREBY MADE A PART OF THIS ORDER.

Exemptions:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this restriction:

1. Persons with a permit issued by a forest officer specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Contractors and their employees while engaged in official business within the area.
4. Landowners with private property within the closed area.

Penalty: Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both (16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571).
