2013 Motor Vehicle Use Map Available

Colville, WA - With Spring here, it's a great time to prepare for your recreation plans on the Colville National Forest. The 2013 Motor Vehicle Use Maps (MVUM) are here and available at all Colville National Forest offices. The MVUM shows the Colville National Forest roads and trails designated open to motor vehicle use on the Colville National Forest.

The maps contain important information on which routes are legally open, prohibitions regarding motor vehicle use on the Forest, and operator responsibilities. If a motor vehicle is operated off the designated route system shown on the MVUM, the operator is subject to fines of up to \$5,000 or imprisonment for up to 6 months or both. Additional penalties may apply to motor vehicle operators creating resource damage (causing ruts or damaging vegetation), when driving on muddy roads and trails.

The MVUMs are free and available at all Colville National Forest Offices, The Kettle Falls Regional Information Center, and the Bureau of Land Management Office on North Fancher in Spokane. The MVUMs are also available on the Colville National Forest Web site at www.fs.usda.gov/colville/ under Maps and Publications.
