

POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

COCONINO NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area, roads, and trails described in this order (*) within the Coconino National Forest, until further notice.

- (1) **Possessing a beverage which is defined as an alcoholic beverage by State Law (Arizona Revised Statutes – Title 4). 36 CFR 261.58 (bb).**

It is unlawful for any person to consume or possess an alcoholic beverage under the age of twenty-one.

It is unlawful for any person to consume or possess an open alcoholic beverage within the driver or passenger compartment of a motor vehicle located on any National Forest System road.

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) **Persons over 21-years of age not in possession of an open alcoholic container or consuming alcohol while in the driver or passenger compartment of a motor vehicle as defined by State Law (Arizona Revised Statute, Title 4-251).**

***This order affects the entire Coconino National Forest.**
