

ORDER

ROAD CLOSURES

COCONINO NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 261.50 (a) and/or (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area, roads, and trails described in this order(*) within the Coconino National Forest until further notice.

- (1) **Being on the Road, 36 CFR 261.54 (e).**

Pursuant to 36 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 261.50 (c), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

(*)This prohibition affects Forest Development Roads upon National Forest System lands within the Coconino National Forest that have been, or are in the process of being obliterated by natural or mechanical means, and removed from the Forest Travel Route Inventory.

Violations of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for individuals, or \$10,000 for a group or organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6-months, or both.
