

ORDER

DISPERSED CAMPING STAY LIMITS

COCONINO NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 261.50 (a) and/or (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area, roads, and trails described in this order(*) within the Coconino National Forest until further notice.


- (1) Camping for period longer than 14-days within any 30-day period, 36 CFR 261.58 (a).
- (2) Camping within 1-mile of a developed recreation site, 36 CFR 261.58 (e).

Pursuant to 36 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

(*)This order affects the entire Coconino National Forest.

Violations of these prohibition are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual, or \$10,000 for a group or organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6-months, or both.
