

ORDER

POSSESSING/STORING/TRANSPORTING
TREES/PLANTS

COCONINO NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 Code of Federal Regulations 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited within the Coconino National Forest until further notice:

(1) Possessing or transporting any part of a tree or plant without a permit. 36 CFR 261.58 (t).

(2) Possessing, storing, transporting marijuana - (*Cannabis sativa* L. as defined by Title 21 United States Code Section 802). 36 CFR 261.58 (t)


Pursuant to 36 Code of Federal Regulations 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

(1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

(2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This Order applies to all areas, roads, and trails within the boundaries of the Coconino National Forest.
