

ORDER

PROHIBITED USES  
CITY OF FLAGSTAFF WATERSHED - INNER BASIN AREA

COCONINO NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 Code of Federal Regulations, Sec. 261.50 (a), the following acts are prohibited on the area described in this order (or Exhibit A\*) within the Coconino National Forest until further notice.

- (1) Being in the area after sundown or before sunrise.  
36 CFR 261.58 (1).
- (2) Go into, or be upon the area with domestic livestock.  
36 CFR 261.53 (e).
- (3) Riding, hitching, tethering of hobbling a horse or other saddle or pack animal. 36 CFR 261.58 (aa).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- (3) Peaks Grazing Allotment permittee to remove estrayed livestock.

\*This order affects the Peaks Ranger District and includes portions of the Inner Basin located in Township 22 North, Range 7, East, Sections 4, 5, and Township 23 North, Range 7 East, Sections 27, 28, 29, 32, 33, and 34.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$500 or imprisonment for not more than 6 month or both.


