

ORDER
OCCUPANCY AND USE OF STONEMAN LAKE
COCONINO NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant of 36 CFR 261.50(a), the area below the rim of Stoneman Lake shown on Exhibit A, is subject to the following prohibitions for the protection of property and resources.

- (1) Possessing or using a vehicle off-Forest development roads, 36 CFR 261.56.
- (2) Camping, 36 CFR 261.58(e).
- (3) Parking or leaving a vehicle except at areas developed for that purpose, 36 CFR 261.58(g).
- (4) Launching a boat except at designated area, 36 CFR 261.58(r).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e) each of the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with permits authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
