

Utah Department of Transportation Road Projects- June 21, 2013

1. Highway 40 Chip Seal: Starting this Sunday (6/23) UDOT will begin patch work on US Highway 40 from the Main Street (US189) intersection to approximately 10 miles southeast (approximately Center Canyon area). Starting on Tuesday, they will begin chip sealing the same stretch and the Highway will have lane restrictions and one-way flagging operations. The work is anticipated to be completed by the end of the week (approximately Friday, 6/28). Approximately two weeks later (after the July 4th weekend), they will be back to complete finish work (lane striping, etc). Delays will occur to motorists, and our employees will need to be extra careful when entering or exiting the Heber Office parking lot.
2. During the same time frame crews will be working on State Road 113 (Midway Center St./Charleston Road) between Midway Main Street and US 189. The majority of the road work will be completed in a week; however bridge work where the road crosses the Provo River will continue into late July and the sidewalk over the bridge will be closed during this time. The same restrictions described above will occur.
3. Beginning approximately the second week of July (after the July 4th weekend), UDOT crews will begin resurfacing S.R. 32 from the U.S. Highway 40 intersection to approximately Victory Ranches/past the Jordanelle Rock Cliff entrance. Lane restrictions and one-way flagging operations will also be in place on this project and will continue through October, 2013. This will impact travel between the Heber and Kamas offices/work areas. UDOT cannot restrict traffic flow for more than 15 minutes at a time, however, depending on traffic, that time could increase to allow for traffic to flow through the work zones. Using S.R. 248 to/from U.S. Highway 40 may be an wise alternate route.
