

Kaibab National Forest
Notice of Herbicide Application
July 2, 2013

If conditions are appropriate, the Williams Ranger District will be applying herbicide the weeks of July 8, 15, and 22 (2013) to control bull thistle and knapweed, both of which are exotic invasive plant species. Herbicide will be applied using backpack sprayers and/or UTVs and will occur on: 1) County Road 141 (east of Wright Hill); 2) the Transwestern Pipeline (north of Three Sisters); 3) FS Road 122 (south of Bill Williams Mountain; and 4) the Elk Springs Timber Sale (north of Sitgreaves Mountain). Crews will use Milestone and/or Telar, both non-restricted use herbicides, mixed with seed oil surfactant and blue dye. The dye is used to mark the sprayed vegetation. Signs will be posted in treated areas.
