


## Map of El Yunque Tram System



### Tram Operations:

Tram will operate from 10AM to 5PM  
Wednesdays through Sundays from July 3-  
August 11

Tram will stop only at designated stops be-  
tween Yokahu Tower and Mt Britton trail-  
head and will pass by approximately every  
30 minutes

### Stops include:

- Yokahu Tower
- Big Tree Trail
- Sierra Palm
- Palo Colorado
- Mt. Britton trailhead

Park only in parking areas or signed parking  
spaces along the main road.

Parking at Yokahu Tower and the south part  
of Sierra Palm Recreation parking area will  
be limited to 1 hour

Traffic on Mt Britton loop (PR Rd 9938) is a  
one-way route, please follow the directional  
signs

There is no cost to using the tram during  
the pilot phase

## El Yunque Tram System - Pilot Phase

For your safety remain seated at all times when the tram is in motion and remember to watch your children when using the tram

For passenger convenience there are racks available in the trailer units to hold some personal items such as backpacks and small coolers

Remember to always stay in contact with members of your family or group so you don't get separated

A recorded message on the tram will announce stops and associated facilities

The tram has capacity to accommodate some accessibility needs including wheelchairs

The El Yunque Tram is a joint effort of the US Forest Service and the Municipality of Rio Grande who operate and maintain the tram
