Road Number	Additional Information
42	By Special Request Only – LSR and Warm Springs Reservation.
4220	Firewood cutting is allowed within 100' of the road up to 0.9 miles past the end of the paved section. Wood cutting within the road prism only to the Olallie Scenic Area boundary. No firewood cutting within Olallie Scenic Area - Except by Special Request
4240	Firewood cutting is only allowed within the road prism and 100' of road side for the first 2.5 miles from the 42 road junction.
4245	Firewood cutting is allowed within 100' of the road from the 42 junction to the 220 spur junction.
45	Firewood Cutting allowed by Special Request only because of checkerboard land ownership.
4510	From Hillockburn: Road prism only from 45 junction to 130 spur and 2.7 miles beyond 130 spur junction. The next 1.3 miles firewood cutting is ok up to 100' from road edge. The next 1.3 miles is road prism only. The remainder of the road (0.4 miles) firewood cutting is ok up to 100' from road edge.
4520	Open within road prism and 100' of the road between the 120 spur and the 4510 junction.
4530	By Special Request Only – BLM land checkerboard.
4531	By Special Request Only-BLM land checkerboard.
4545	From the West Junction (Hillockburn side): Wood cutting within road prism and 100' of the road for the first 0.3 miles. Continue Road Prism only for the next 1.3 miles. Continue road prism and within 100' of the road for the next 1.5 miles. Continue within the road prism and within 100' of the Northwest side of the road only to the 130 spur (LSR/Wilderness). Continue within the road prism and 100' of both sides of the road from the 130 spur to the East junction of the 45 road. No woodcutting outside of the road prism of the 130 spur.
4550	Wood cutting within road prism and the Southeast side of the road for the first 1 mile from the 45 junction. Continue road prism only for the next 0.3 miles (LSR). Continue wood cutting within the road prism and 100' of both sides of the road for the next 6.0 miles.
4610	No wood cutting from HWY 224 to 4611 junction. BLM land and Forest Service Timber Sale activity. Beyond the 4611 junction, woodcutting is allowed within 100' of the road.
4614	Wood cutting within the road prism only North of the 180 spur road. If you are travelling on Tumala Mtn Road (Squaw Mtn. Road) from HWY 224 you will need to drive approximately 10 miles before you come to National Forest Land. Clear-cut areas and blue gates are not on Mt. Hood National Forest land. Your permit is only valid on Mt. Hood National Forest land.
4615	Wood cutting within road prism and 100' of the road for the first 0.3 miles. Continue Road Prism only for the next 0.3 miles. Continue within road prism and 100' of the road for the next 2.1 miles. Continue road prism and within 100' of the West side of the road only for the remaining 3.1 miles. If you are travelling on Tumala Mountain Road (Squaw Mtn. Road) from HWY 224 you will need to drive approximately 10 miles before you come to National Forest Land. Clear-cut areas and blue gates are not on Mt. Hood National Forest land. Your permit is only valid on Mt. Hood National Forest land.
4620	Wood cutting within the road prism only for 1.3 miles from HWY 224 (LSR). For the next 1.5 miles wood cutting is allowed within 100' of the west side road, no wood cutting outside of the road prism on the East side of the road (LSR). Beyond 2.8 miles from HWY 224 junction, wood cutting is allowed within 100' on both sides of the road. <b>Do not cut on any decked logs that may be along this road.</b>

4621	No wood cutting. Timber sale activity.
4630	Wood cutting within road prism and 100' of the road for the first 1.5 miles (from the 224 junction). Continue road prism only for 0.4 miles (Non-FS land). Continue woodcutting within road prism and 100' of the road for the remainder of the road. On the 200 Spur: Wood cutting within the road prism only the first 1.7 miles traveling from the HWY 224 junction (LSR).
4635	Wood cutting within road prism and within 100' of the South side of the road only. No wood cutting North of the 017 spur road (LSR & Wilderness).
4645	Wood cutting within road prism only for the first 0.7 miles (LSR). Continue within road prism and 100' of the road for the next 2 miles. Wood cutting within road prism only for the remainder of the road (LSR).
4651	Wood cutting within the road prism and within 100' of the West side of the road only for the length of the road (LSR). There is timber sale activity along this road. Expect delays due to active logging along this road system.
4671	No wood cutting from the 4670 road junction to the 4672 road junction because of Timber Sale Activity. No wood cutting on spur roads 012, 130, 120, 140, 150, 160.
4680	Wood cutting within road prism only for the first 1.1 miles. Woodcutting within road prism and 100' of the East side of the road for the next 1.4 miles. Continue wood cutting within the road prism only for the remainder of the road (LSR). It is ok to cut on any decked logs found on this road.
5710	Wood cutting is allowed within 100' of the road on both sides from the 57 junction to 0.75 miles from the 5720 junction. For the last 0.75 miles to the 5720 junction wood cutting within 100' of the road is only allowed on the north side of the 5710 road.
5720	Wood cutting is allowed within 100' of the road on both sides of the road until the 5710 junction. From the 5710 junction to the 180 spur wood cutting within 100' of the road is only allowed on the north side. Wood cutting on the 180 spur is allowed within 100' of the road on the north side up to the 016 spur. Beyond the 016 spur, wood cutting is allowed within 100' of both sides of the road.
58	Wood cutting is allowed within road prism and 100' of both sides of the road for the first 4 miles from junction with Road 57. Wood cutting within the road prism only for the next 7 miles to the 5855 road. From the 5855 road to Little Crate Lake Campground wood cutting is allowed within road prism and 100' of the road. No wood cutting from the 42 road to Little Crater Lake Campground (CTWS Land). Wood cutting within the road prism only on spur roads 138, 150, 140, 180, 160, 170, 174, 175, 031, 030 (LSR).
5820	Traveling from the West end junction with the 5810 - Woodcutting with road prism and 100' of the road for the first 1.5 miles to the 150 junction. Continue woodcutting within road prism and within 100' of the South side of the road only for 2.3 miles. Continue wood cutting within road prism and both sides of the road to the East end junction with the 5810 road.
5830	Wood cutting within the road prism and 100' of the road for the first 0.8 miles. Continue road prism and within 100' of the South side of the road for the next 2.2 miles. Continue road prism and within 100' of the road for the next 2.5 miles. Continue road prism and within 100' of the East side of the road only for the next 0.7 miles. Continue road prism and both sides of the road for the next 1 mile. Continue road prism and within 100' of the East side of the road only for the remainder of the road.
63	No wood cutting from the 46 road junction to the 6350 road junction. South of the 6350 road junction, wood cutting is allowed only on the East side of the road (LSR).
6310	No wood cutting on spur roads: 011, 012, 120, 016, 125, 131, 150, 173, 175, 178.
6311	No wood cutting on spur road 160.
6320	No wood cutting. Timber Sale activity.
6321	Road is seasonally closed (gated) through August 1 <sup>st</sup> . Wood cutting is allowed within road prism and 100' of the road from the 6320 junction to the 6321-120 spur road. North of the 120 spur it is road prism only.
6330	No wood cutting. Timber Sale activity.

6340	Wood cutting within the road prism only from the 63 junction to the 018 spur road junction (LSR). Beyond the 018 junction wood cutting is ok within road prism and 100' of the edge of the road prism.
6341	Wood cutting within the road prism only on the 230 spur road (LSR)
7010	No wood cutting from the 70 road junction to the 120 spur road junction due to timber sale activity. Wood cutting within 100' of the remainder of the road is ok. No wood cutting on spur road 019.
7020	Only the first mile on the West side of the road is open to wood cutting within road prim and 100' of the road.
7030	Only spur road 120 is open for wood cutting within 100' of the road on the West side of the road.
