

## Cabinet Mountains Wilderness (Southwestern portion)

### Trail Report 7/12/13

- **Chicago Peak:** Trailhead is accessible. Trail into Cliff Lake is unmaintained. High clearance vehicle is strongly recommended.
- **St. Paul Lake, Trail #646:** Trail is clear of snow and blow down.
- **Swamp Creek and Lost Buck Pass, Trail #912:** Trail is clear of snow and blow down to 6.5 miles in. Intermittent blow down beyond. The status of the section of trail up to Lost Buck Pass is unknown.
- **Goat Ridge, Trail #921:** Trail is clear of snow and blow down.
- **Bear Paw, Trail #923:** Trail is clear of snow and blow down.
- **Wanless Lake, Trail #924:** Trail is clear of snow and blow down to 4.5 miles in at junction with Goat Ridge Trail #921.
- **Engle Peak, Trail #926:** Trail is clear of snow and blow down to junction with Engle Lake Trail #935.
- **Engle Lake, Trail #932:** Trailhead is clear of snow and blow down to 2.5 miles in.
- **Rock Lake, Trail #935:** Trail is clear of snow and blow down.
- **Devils Club, Trail #966:** Trail is clear of snow and blow down
- **North Fork Bull River, Trail #972:** Trail is clear of snow and blow down. Be advised road #2722 is washed out at the junction of road #410. This adds approximately 1.5 miles to the hike.
- **Middle Fork Bull River, Trail #978:** Trail is clear of snow and blow down. Be advised road #2722 is washed out at the junction of road #410. This adds approximately .75 miles to the hike.
- **Dad Peak, Trail #987:** Trail is clear of snow, blow down amount unknown.
- **Moran Basin, Trail #993:** Trail is clear of snow and blow down
