**AREA CLOSURE
Road 210 Fire – Version 1
For Public Safety**

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act is prohibited on all roads, trails, and areas within the Sawtooth National Recreation Area, Sawtooth National Forest. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.

1. Going into or being upon an Area. **36 CFR 261.52(e)**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order;
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.
4. Owners of private property may travel through the closure area for the sole purpose of ingress and egress of their private property.
5. Developed campgrounds along the Salmon River between Stanley and Robinson Bar road are open to use.

AREA DESCRIPTION:

The Road 210 Fire – (including all roads and trails within the area) is described as follows: Starting at the intersection of State Highway 75 and Hell Roaring Road #315 proceed south along the west side of State Highway 75 to the north boundary of T8N, R14E, Sections 20 and 19; thence following the north boundary of Section 20 west until intersecting with Trail #192. Thence proceeding southwesterly along and including Trail #192 until reaching Trail #096; thence proceeding along and excluding Trail #096 to Trail #040; then proceeding along but excluding Trail #040 until intersecting with Trail #092; thence along and excluding Trail #092 until reaching the Boise County and Custer County line. Then proceed along the County boundary line in a northerly direction until intersecting with the northern boundary of T9N, R12E, Section 2; Then proceed due west until the intersection of R12E and R13E; proceed north until reaching the northern boundary of T10N, R13E, Section 19. Proceed due east, crossing State Highway 75 until reaching the eastern side of the Salmon River. Then proceed north and then east along Salmon River on the southeast side of the river until reaching west side of Robinson Bar Road #454; proceed southerly along but excluding Road #454 until reaching the west side of Trail #671, thence proceed southerly along but excluding Trail #671 until reaching Trail #219; then proceeding southerly along but excluding Trail #219 to Trail #109; thence proceeding west along and excluding Trail #109 until reaching Road #209 (4th of July Creek Road); thence proceeding

west along and excluding Road #209, until reaching the intersection of State Highway 75 and Hell Roaring Road #315 and the point of beginning.

The above described Area (including all roads and trails within the Area) are located on National Forest System lands within the administrative and proclaimed boundaries of the Sawtooth National Recreation Area within the Sawtooth National Forest, Custer County, Idaho, Boise Meridian.


PURPOSE:

These closures are necessary to provide protection to forest visitors from the current fire safety hazards associated with the **Road 210 Fire**.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the closure area is attached and made part of this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. 16 U.S.C. §551, 18 U.S.C. §§ 3571(b)(6), 3581 (b)(7).
4. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this Order in the areas (and/or roads, trails) covered by this Order.
5.
