ORDER RSF-205

EMERGENCY CLOSURE - FIRE

ROGUE RIVER-SISKIYOU NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR Part 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited within the boundaries of the Wild Rivers Ranger District, Rogue River-Siskiyou National Forest, as described in this order and attached map (Exhibit A), to provide for public health and safety due to active fire and extreme fire conditions in the area until August 31, 2013, or unless sooner rescinded.

1. Being on a trail. [36 CFR 261.55(a)]

- Forest Trail 1161/1162 also known as the Illinois River Trail

2. Being on a Forest road. [36 CFR 261.54(e)]

- Forest Road #4103 from the forest boundary to its terminus.

The legal location of the closed roads are in: T.38S, R.8W, Sections 7 and 8; T. 38S, R. 9W, Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 11, 12; T. 37S, R. 9W, Sections 6, 7, 8, 16, 17, 21, 28, 29, 32, 33.

- Forest Road #4103.152 from the Forest boundary to the junction with Forest Road #2512.675

The legal location of the closed road is in: T.37S, R.9W, Sections 4 and 5.

- Forest Road #4105 from the junction with Forest Road #4103 to its terminus.

The legal location of the closed roads are in: T.37S, R.9W, Sections 3, 4, 10, 15, 16, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 34, 35, 36; and T. 38S, R.9W, Section 2.

3. Being on land within a Campground. [36 CFR 261.53(e)]

- The developed recreation site known as Sixmile Campground.

The legal location is: T.38S, R.9W, Section 2.

- The developed recreation site known as Riverbench Recreation Area.

The legal location is: T.38S, R.9W, Section 3.

- The developed recreation site known as Store Gulch Campground.

The legal location is: T.38S, R.9W, Section 3.

- The developed recreation site known as Echo Beach Campground.

The legal location is: T.37S, R.9W, Section 33.

- The developed recreation site known as Iron Ring Campground.

The legal location is: T.37S, R.9W, Section 33.

- The developed recreation site known as Cedar Camp.

The legal location is: T.37S, R.9W, Section 17.

- The developed recreation site known as Briggs Creek Campground.

The legal location is: T.37S, R.9W, Section 6.

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR Part 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from the Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or Local Law Enforcement Officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire-fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

This Order will become effective immediately.

Violation of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both, for each offense. [16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571]
