

2013 White Mountain National Forest Service
Invasive Plant Planned Treatment Sites

The following sites may be treated using mechanical methods (e.g., mowing, hand cutting, or hand pulling), chemical herbicides (Garlon 4, Roundup Pro, Accord, Rodeo, Transline), or a combination of both. Most sites are very small (<0.1 acre) consisting of only a few plants. All non-native invasive plants removed by hand pulling will be disposed of in a manner that will not lead to further infestation elsewhere. All herbicide applications will be done under the supervision of a licensed pesticide applicator and following state permit requirements.
