**DUSTY CAMPGROUND AT LAKE BRITTON TO BE CLOSED WHILE PG&E
UPGRADES RECREATION FACILITIES**
Dusty Campground Closed August 1 through end of 2013 But Other Campsites Available

BURNEY, Calif. – Dusty Campground on Lake Britton will be closed August 1 and reopen by January 2014 while Pacific Gas and Electric Company's (PG&E) contractor makes improvements to the campground and other sites at Lake Britton.

During the campground closure, there are a variety of other campsites available nearby including PG&E's Northshore Campground on Lake Britton and Cassel Campgrounds near Hat Creek; McArthur-Burney Falls Memorial State Park on Lake Britton; the Bureau of Land Management's Pit River Campground just upstream of the lake; and the U.S. Forest Service's Rocky, Bridge, Cave and Hat Creek campgrounds located along Hat Creek and Honn Campground located near the Thousands Lake Wilderness Area.

E.C. Smith of Anderson, an approved contractor with PG&E, will be constructing the Lake Britton recreation improvements. At Dusty Campground, PG&E will provide new picnic tables and gravel spurs at its existing campsites, two new walk-in campsites; two sand beaches, and accessibility improvements.

PG&E will also provide a new 10-unit picnic area with a sand beach at the Ferry Crossing, just upstream of the lake's dam; a new rest stop with information and interpretive panels at 5-Corners; and a new single-vault restroom at the Gasline Boat Launch located on the north shore of upper Lake Britton.
