

ORDER NUMBER SJ-2013-16
SPECIAL ROAD CLOSURE
San Juan National Forest

Pursuant to Title 16 U.S.C. § 551, and 36 CFR §§ 261.50(a) and 261.50(b), the following is prohibited within the Pagosa Ranger District of the San Juan National Forest, Archuleta County, State of Colorado.

PROHIBITIONS:

Using any motorized vehicle on National Forest System Road (NFSR) 681, also known as the Chris Mountain Road. 36 C.F.R. 261.54(a).

This closure is further depicted on the attached map hereby incorporated and included in this Order as Exhibit 1. In addition, signs are posted in accordance with 36 CFR § 261.51 at each end of the road. The purpose of this restriction is protection of public health and safety relating to logging operations occurring in the immediate vicinity of and on the Chris Mountain Road.

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or any member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in performance of an official duty;
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

This Order shall remain in effect until rescinded, or until December 31, 2013, whichever event occurs first.

Violations of the prohibition are punishable by fines of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for a corporation and up to six months imprisonment (18 USC 3571).
