**INTEGRATED RESOURCE TIMBER CONTRACT FLOWERY TRAIL
STEWARDSHIP**

COLVILLE NATIONAL FOREST

The Flowery Trail Stewardship Integrated Resource Timber Contract is located within T32N, R42E, Sections 11,12,13,14,15,23,24, and T32N, R43E, Sections 8,17,18,19,20,21,28,29, 32,33, W.M., Surveyed, Pend Orielle County, Washington. The Forest Service will receive technical and price proposals (no public opening) at the Colville National Forest Supervisor's Office, 765 S. Main St., Colville, Washington no later than 8:30 AM local time on or before September 23, 2013 for an estimated 95,513 Tons Douglas-fir and Other Coniferous Species Sawtimber, and 17,148 Tons of Grn Bio Cv marked or otherwise designated for cutting. In addition, the contract area contains an unestimated volume of All Species Grn Bio Cv that the offeror may agree to remove at a fixed rate. Also included in the contract are thirteen (13) mandatory and nine (9) optional restorative service projects to be completed by the Contractor. The contract will be awarded based on a Best Value determination. One award will be made to the Offeror (a) whose proposal is technically acceptable and (b) whose technical/price relationship is the most advantageous to the Government. The Forest Service reserves the right to reject any and all proposals. Interested parties may obtain a prospectus from the office listed below. A prospectus, offer form, and complete information concerning the timber, the restoration service projects, the conditions of sale, and submission of offers is available to the public from the Colville National Forest Supervisor's Office, 765 S.
