

The Tahoe National Forest is soliciting competitive offers for the Camp Stewardship Project. The Camp Stewardship Project is located within portions of Section 25, T19N; R7E; portions of Sections 14, 16, 17, 18, 19, 21, 22, 23, 26, 27, 28, 33, 34, T19N; R8E; and, portions of Sections 2, 3, 10, 11, 19, T18N; R8E, M.D.M. Sealed – “Best Value” offers will be received at the Forest Supervisor's Office at 631 Coyote Street Nevada City, CA 95959 by 10:30 AM local time on, on September 9, 2013, for an estimated 58,795.56 Tons (9,810 MBF) of sawtimber marked or otherwise designated for cutting on 1288.46 acres and 13 stewardship projects. Stewardship projects are: small tree (non-sawtimber) thinning and removal on 544.22 acres, and decommissioning 5 road segments. In addition, deposits are required for surface replacement, brush disposal and road maintenance. The Forest Service will evaluate competitive offers submitted by offerors who present a price offer and technical proposal according to the information found under the section in the offer titled “Instructions to Offerors.” Evaluation factors for this project are organizational experience, organizational past performance, local community economic enhancement (including small business enhancement), understanding the Government’s requirements, and price. One award will be made to the offeror whose proposal is technically acceptable and whose technical/price relationship is the “best value” to the Government.
