

**EMERGENCY OCCUPANCY AND USE RESTRICTIONS
NATIONAL FOREST AREAS AND NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM TRAILS AND ROADS**

**DESCHUTES NATIONAL FOREST
SISTERS RANGER DISTRICT**

Pursuant to 16 USC, 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b) the following acts are prohibited on areas and designated sections of National Forest system trails and roads as described below, and as shown on the attached map, within the Deschutes National Forest, hereby incorporated into this order as Attachment 'A'.

Beginning at a point located at the intersection of Forest Roads 11 and 1120 in Township 13 South, Range 09 East, Section 25; thence north along Forest Road 1120 to its intersection with Forest Road 14 in section 2; thence north along Forest Road 14 to its intersection with Forest Road 1490 in section 11; thence northeast thence southeast along Forest Road 1490 to its intersection with Forest Road 1140 in section 6; thence south along Forest Road 1140 to its intersection with Forest Road 1154 in section 18; thence east along Forest Road 1154 to its intersection with Forest Road 1150 in section 18; thence south along Forest Road 1150 to its intersection with Forest Road 11 in section 5; thence south along Forest Road 11 back to the point of beginning.

INCLUDING:

- Forest Road 14 at its intersection with Forest Road 1490 in Township 12 South, Range 09 East, Section 11; thence north on Forest Road 14 to its intersection with Forest Road 12 in section 2; thence east on Forest Road 12 to its intersection with Forest Road 1270 in Township 12 South, Range 09 East, Section 2.
- Forest Road 1140 at its intersection with Forest Road 1149 in Township 12 South, Range 10 East, Section 6; thence west along Forest Road 1140 to its intersection with Forest Road 1490 in Township 12 South, Range 10 East, Section 6.
- East Metolius Trail (#4020) at its intersection with Forest Road 1400420 in Township 12 South, Range 09 East, Section 27; thence north along the East Metolius Trail to its intersection with Lower Bridge Campground in Township 12 South; Range 09 East; Section 2.
- Wizard Falls Fish Hatchery, Allen Springs Campground, Pioneer Ford Campground, and Lower Bridge Campground.

PROHIBITIONS

It is prohibited to go into or be upon any of the above described lands which are closed for the protection of public health and safety, including all National Forest System roads and trails therein. 36 CFR § 261.53(e)

Being on a forest system road. 36 CFR § 261.54(e)

These restrictions are in addition to those prohibitions enumerated in Subpart A of 36CFR§261 and any other special restrictions pertaining to the described lands.

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR§261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order:

1. Personnel with written authorization by a Forest Officer, which specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act or omission. The issuing Officer may include such conditions as are considered necessary for the protection of the area, or for the promotion of the health, safety, or welfare of its users.
2. Any Federal, State, or local Officer or volunteer in the performance of an official duty.
3. Persons or their invitees who live or own property within the closure area, and permittees who have a legitimate need to access their permitted allotment if escorted or approved by IMT.
4. Forest Road 14 south of the intersection of Forest Road 1419900.
5. Forest Road 1120 shall remain open.
6. Forest Roads 11 shall remain open.

This closure is enacted due to firefighting activities taking place within the closure area, and for the protection of public and employee safety. This order replaces Order # 06-01-05-13-001, which is hereby rescinded. These prohibitions will remain in effect until rescinded.

This order becomes effective at 1700, August 8, 2013, and will remain in force until rescinded.


