

**TEMPORARY AREA AND USE RESTRICTIONS  
FOREST SERVICE SYSTEM ROADS AND WILDERNESS**

**DESCHUTES NATIONAL FOREST**

Pursuant to 16 USC, Title 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following special restrictions and prohibitions are established on Forest Roads, trails, and within the boundary lines of the Pole Creek Fire Area on the Deschutes National Forest, Sisters Ranger District, where signed on the ground and as shown on the attached map and described in the map legend, hereby incorporated into this order as attachment A.

Closed Forest Service System Roads:

- 1514-600 in its entirety
- 1514-685 in its entirety
- 1600-600 to jct. 1600-620 in its entirety
- 1600-620 in its entirety
- 1600-700 from its jct. with 1600-730 South to 16

**PROHIBITIONS**

**Going into or being upon an area. 36 CFR § 261.52(e)**

**Being on a road. 36§CFR 261.54(e)**

This restriction is in addition to those prohibitions enumerated in Subpart A of 36CFR§261 and any other special restrictions pertaining to the described lands.

**EXEMPTIONS**

**Pursuant to 36 CFR§261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:**

1. Personnel with written authorization by a Forest Officer, which specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act. The issuing Officer may include such conditions as are considered necessary for the protection of the area, or for the promotion of the health, safety, or welfare of its users.
2. Any Federal, State, or local Officer or volunteer in the performance of an official duty.
3. Persons under a special use authorization that allows the otherwise prohibited action, and approved contractors and their agents directly engaged in approved work outlined in an operating plan or permit.
4. Persons traveling over snow for the purpose of winter recreation use.
5. Those persons not operating a motor vehicle on Forest System Roads listed and depicted in this order as being closed.
6. Persons within 50 feet of the center line of those Forest Service system trails within the Pole Creek Fire listed as open, and as described below.

Open Trail names and Trail numbers:

- Green Lakes Trail # 4070
- Pole Creek Trail # 4072
- Camp Lake Trail # 4074
- Park Meadow Trail # 4075
- Chush Falls Trail # 4080

**These restrictions are enacted due to fire recovery and rehabilitation activities taking place within the described fire area, and for the protection of public and employee safety.**

This order becomes effective at 12:00 PM, August 9, 2013, and will remain in force until rescinded. This order replaces Order # 06-01-05-12-008, which is hereby rescinded.


