The Los Padres National Forest is currently conducting outreach to fill permanent full time GS- 401-12/13 Ecosystem Staff Officer position. This notification is being circulated to inform prospective applicants of this opportunity and to determine interest.

**BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:** Performs as the Ecosystem Staff Officer. This position serves as a Resources/Planning Staff Officer and principal staff assistant to the Forest Supervisor and Deputy Forest Supervisor with primary responsibility for providing forest wide leadership, coordination and long-range forest planning and management guidance for Resources and National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) compliance programs. Resource areas include: Watershed, Wildlife, Aquatics, Plants, Range, Timber and Vegetation Management (including hazardous fuels management). Planning and GIS. Supervision is a component of this position, and includes supervision of employees performing work at the GS-12 and GS-11 levels.
