The Forest Service will receive sealed bids in public at Mount Hough RD, 39696 Hwy 70, QUINCY, CA at 10:30 AM local time on 08/28/2013 for an estimated volume of 3304.5 MBF of Douglas Fir sawtimber, 551.2 MBF of Incense Cedar sawtimber, .9 MBF of Lodgepole Pine sawtimber, 1025.3 MBF of Ponderosa Pine sawtimber, 1813.7 MBF of Sugar Pine sawtimber, 1421.2 MBF of White Fir/Red Fir sawtimber marked or otherwise designated for cutting in 22 standard tractor harvest subdivisions and 5 roadside hazard harvest subdivisions. In addition, there is within the sale area an un-estimated volume of Combined Softwood sawtimber in 7 skyline harvest subdivisions and Combined Softwood cull logs in all harvest subdivisions that the bidder may agree to remove at a fixed rate.
