

OCCUPANCY AND USE

**MT. HOOD NATIONAL FOREST
CLACKAMAS RIVER RANGER DISTRICT**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b) the following acts are prohibited within the areas depicted in "Attachment A" and "Attachment B" on the Mt Hood National Forest. These areas are generally defined as the LaDee Flat OHV area and a portion of "Memaloose" Road 45 and their environs.

These prohibitions shall be in effect until rescinded or 08/27/2015.

1. Discharging a firearm, air rifle or gas gun, except in lawful pursuit of a game animal as defined by State Law.

36 CFR 261.58(m)

Pursuant to Title 36 261.50(e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR 261.




Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551, and 18 U.S.C 3559 and 3571)

LaDee Flat OHV Area



- A. Lands accessed by Forest Service Road 4610 from the junction on State Highway 224 in T4S, R5E, Section 18 for 12 miles to the junction of Forest Road 4613 and 4614 in T4S, R6E, Section 7, and Forest Road 4611 from junction of 4610 to the junction of 4612 in T4S, R5E, Section 25.
- B. All lands accessed by spur roads originating from Forest Road 4610, 4611, and 4613 contained within T4s R5E, Sections 7, 13, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20,21,22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 28, 36, and 35.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551, and 18 U.S.C 3559 and 3571)




Quarry
