

FOREST ORDER

LARAMIE RIVER ROAD SPURS AND AREA

Pursuant to Title 16 U.S.C. § 551, and Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations (“C.F.R.”), § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on all National Forest System Roads (Forest Service Road 191.0, 191.A, 103.A, 103.C, 103.D, and 103.E) and the area within 500 feet of these roads, within T 8N, R75W, Sections 18 and 19 and T6N, R75W, Sections 2, 10, 11, and 16 of the Canyon Lakes Ranger District of the Roosevelt National Forest, in Larimer County, Colorado, hereinafter referred to as the Restricted Area and Roads. These Restricted Area/Roads are depicted and shown on the attached map hereby incorporated into this order as Exhibit A. This Order is needed for public safety.

PROHIBITIONS:

- Going into or being upon National Forest System Lands and Roads in the Restricted Area. 36 C.F.R. § 261.53(e) and 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e).

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty;
- 2) Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

This Order goes into effect when it is posted and when it is signed on the ground and shall remain in effect until rescinded.
