Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit  
South Shore Fuels Reduction and Healthy Forest Restoration Project

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a), and to provide for public safety, the following act is prohibited within the Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit. This Order is effective every day from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., September 3, 2013, through October 25, 2013.

Going into or being upon Unit 206 of the South Shore Fuels Reduction and Healthy Forest Restoration Project, as shown on the attached map.  
36 CFR 261.53(e).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Persons with a contract from the Forest Service authorizing work on the South Shore Fuels Reduction and Healthy Forest Restoration Project are exempt from the prohibitions listed above to the extent authorized by the contract.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.


A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
