The Sitka District Ranger under the authority granted by the Federal Subsistence Board will hold a public hearing to share information and solicit public comments concerning mountain goat management in Unit 4. The hearing will be held at Harrigan Centennial Hall, 330 Harbor Drive, Sitka on Monday September 16 beginning at 7:00 p.m. in the Rousseau room. The Alaska Department of Fish and Game will also review current management strategies and present information related to mountain goat harvest and population trends.
