

**ORDER**  
**USDA - FOREST SERVICE**  
**COCONINO and TONTO NATIONAL FORESTS**  
**RED ROCK AND PAYSON RANGER DISTRICTS**  
**Glass Food and Beverage Containers Prohibited**

Pursuant to Title 16 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and/or (b), the following acts are prohibited in areas as described in this Order on National Forest System lands administered by the Coconino and Tonto National Forests, in Yavapai and Gila counties in Arizona, and as depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

**PROHIBITIONS:**

1. Possession or use of glass containers within ¼ mile of the center of Fossil Creek in the area described below and in Exhibit A, 36 CFR 261.58 (cc).

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and
2. Person(s) with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
3. Possession of glass containers within a motor vehicle, or within a Forest Service recreation developed site boundary.

**AREA DESCRIBED:**

This order affects the Coconino National Forest and the Tonto National Forest, Red Rock Ranger District and Payson Ranger District within the Fossil Creek Wild and Scenic River Boundary. As shown on the map in Exhibit A. The prohibited area includes the area known as Fossil Creek Wild and Scenic River and is located along Fossil Creek in both Gila and Yavapai counties. The prohibited area begins at the easternmost boundary of the Wild and Scenic River: the confluence of Calf Pen and Stehr canyons and continues downstream on Fossil Creek for approximately 13 miles to a location on Fossil Creek south of the former Stehr Lake in the northeast corner of Section 29. The prohibition includes all National Forest land within this boundary from the center of Fossil Creek to ¼ mile on either side of the creek.

**PURPOSE:**

This order is needed to ensure public health and safety.

**IMPLEMENTATION:**

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until September 1, 2015 or until rescinded, whichever event occurs first.
2. This Order rescinds, replaces and supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order in areas addressed by Exhibit A.


