



Photo Trail, No. 33099

Dixie National Forest, Powell Ranger District

General Description: This short scenic trail climbs to a ridge overlooking Red Canyon to the east and the Sevier River valley to the west.

Trail Use: Foot only

Length: 0.1 miles/0.16 kilometers one way

Trailhead Information: Accessed by a paved road; no restroom is available at the trailhead but is available at the nearby Red Canyon Visitor Center. When it is open.

Elevation in Feet: Min: 7,162 Max: 7,252 Change: 90
(27 meters)

Water Availability: No water is available at the trailhead. Potable water is available at the Red Canyon Visitor Center.

Hazards /Obstacles: Weather can change quickly. Be prepared for inclement weather year round. Flash floods are possible in stream bottoms. There are some steep slopes along the trail.

The Trailhead: Drive east 3 miles from US Highway 89 on Utah Highway 12. The Photo Trail is the first trailhead on your left that you will come to after you enter Red Canyon. Just after driving past the Thunder Mountain trailhead and Dixie National Forest on the right, there will be a turn out for parking on both sides of the road. Then walk on the trail to the north until you find the Photo Trail trailhead sign.

The Trail: This short scenic trail climbs to a ridge overlooking Red Canyon to the east and the Sevier River valley to the west. This is great place to take photos of the beautiful red rock scenery.




