The Southwest Jemez Mountains Restoration project aims to restore a 110,000 acre landscape in the Southwest Jemez Mountains by making it less susceptible to the effects of uncharacteristic wildfire, insects and disease outbreaks and climate change.



The proposal would restore meadows and streams,

reestablish campsites moving them away from water sources, thin the overcrowded forests and remove fuels so we can reintroduce low intensity prescribed fire into the landscape. This fall, a draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) outlining plans and alternative plans for the project will be available for public comment.
