

FOREST ORDER

AREA AND ROADS AND TRAIL CLOSURE

Pursuant to Title 16 U.S.C. § 551, and Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations (“C.F.R.”), § 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on all National Forest System lands in the area on the Boulder Ranger District and the Canyon Lakes Ranger District of the Roosevelt National Forest, in Boulder and Larimer Counties, Colorado, hereinafter referred to as the Restricted Area and Restricted Roads and Restricted Trails. The closure area is described in Exhibit A.

PROHIBITIONS:

- Going into or being upon National Forest System Lands, Roads and Trails in the Restricted Area. 36 C.F.R. § 261.53(e) and 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e) and 36 C.F.R. § 261.55(a).

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty;
- 2) Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission and after consultation with the appropriate Forest Service official prior to entry.
- 3) Residents of the area and those under contract for emergency repair in the area or on the roads.

This Order supersedes, rescinds and replaces Order # ARP-2013-06.

This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until rescinded.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C §§ 3559 and 3571).
