## **PRESCRIBED BURN NOTICE**

The Placerville Ranger District of the Eldorado National Forest will be conducting prescribed understory burns. The prescribed burns will consist of multiple days of ignitions and patrol of hotspots. Ignitions for the prescribed burn are scheduled to occur before the next precipitation event.

**When: November 3 – 9, 2013**

**What: Happy Valley Prescribed Burn**  
Units A, B, C (88 acres)

**Last Chance/Henrys Prescribed Burn**  
Units 54, A, B (216 acres)

**Flemming Prescribed Burn**  
Units C1-4, E1-3 (150 acres)

**Where: 1 Mile East of Happy Valley**  
**2 Miles South of Grizzly Flat**  
**1 Mile South of Jenkinson Lake**

*Legal location:*

Happy Valley Burn: Township 10 North, Range 13 East, Sections 28, 33

Last Chance/Henrys: Township 9 North, Range 13 East, Sections 27, 28, 33, 34

Flemming Burn: Township 10 North, Range 13 East, Sections 20, 21

The objectives of these prescribed burns is to reduce the existing fire hazard, enhance wildlife habitat, and reintroduce fire into a fire-dependent ecosystem.

Ignitions of the prescribed burn are dependent on favorable weather conditions. All attempts will be made to minimize smoke impacts to surrounding communities.
