**PIT RIVER ROAD TO CLOSE BELOW PIT 4 RESERVOIR WHILE PG&E
REPLACES CULVERTS**

Road Closed at Work Locations Nov. 4 to 22

BURNEY, Calif. – Pit River Road will be closed below the Pit 4 Reservoir from Nov. 4 to 22 while a contractor for Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) improves five culverts. The road will reopen on weekends.

Motorists traveling westbound on Pit River Road will be able to go as far as work locations below the Pit 4 Reservoir. Those traveling east from Big Bend by way of Hagen Flat Road to Pit River Road will be able to travel as far as the work sites.

PG&E will post signs advising of the road closure at the Pit 5 Dam and at Five Corners near the Pit 3 dam at Lake Burney.

The work is being conducted in accordance with conditions of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) license for the Pit 3, 4, and 5 Hydroelectric Project issued in July 2007.

All road closure dates and locations are subject to schedule modifications. Changes in the closure dates and locations will be communicated to the public with as much advance notice as possible and will be posted at all appropriate entrances to the construction area.
