

**BANDIT TIMBER SALE Highlights**  
**Iron River Ranger District**  
**OTTAWA NATIONAL FOREST**

- The Bandit Timber Sale Area is along the south side of FR 3110, 2.1 miles south of Iron County Highway 436 (Smokey Lake Road), and 16.1 miles west of Iron River, Michigan.
- 3 of the 11 harvest units have a summer logging opportunity (excludes road right-of-way units).
- Required deposits of \$8,864.02 (\$1.78/CCF) for deferred maintenance of roads by the Forest Service will be paid by the Purchaser in addition to Current Contract Rates.
