

ORDER NO. 13-17  
TEMPORARY CLOSURE  
SAN BERNARDINO NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(b), and to protect natural resources, the following act is prohibited within the San Bernardino National Forest. This Order is effective from December 1, 2013 through April 1, 2014.

Being on the National Forest System trails listed below and shown on Exhibit A.

1. Gray's Peak Trail, from its intersection with Forest Road No. 2N70, then north to Hanna Flat Campground.
2. Gray's Peak Spur Trail, from its intersection with Forest Road No. 2N70, then south to the end of the trail at Gray's Peak.

36 CFR 261.55(a).


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission
2. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
