

The Upper Rio Grande Nordic Club maintains ski and snowshoe trails on public lands in the Mineral County area. Volunteer members maintain the trails.

2013-2014 Trail Information:

Deep Creek Cross Country Ski Trail is one of four maintained by URGNC through a National Forest Service permit. It is located at the Forest Service Administration Site on the east end of Deep Creek Road. There are two trailheads: one on Deep Creek Road about 1 mile west of Colorado Hwy. 149 and the other just to the west of that at the Forest Service Administration Site.

Ivy/Lime Creek Cross Country Ski Trail is located off Middle Creek Road, which is seven miles past Creede on Highway 149. Take Middle Creek Road past Spar City.

Sixmile Flats Trail is the newest of the URGNC's trails. It begins at the intersection of Middle Creek Road seven miles past Creede on Highway 140. The trail goes to the east from the trailhead on Moonshine Mesa and is great for beginners.

Spring Creek Ski Trail is located off Hwy 149 at the Spring Creek Pass Corrals.
