NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROADS

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(b), and to provide for public safety and to protect natural resources, the following act is prohibited within the Hume Lake Ranger District of the Sequoia National Forest. This Order is effective from December 19, 2013 through May 30, 2014.

Using any type of motorized wheeled vehicle on the National Forest System roads listed below and shown on the attached map. This prohibition does not apply to the use of wheeled-all-terrain vehicles and tracked-over-the-snow vehicles when there is snow on the road. A tracked-over-the-snow vehicle is defined as any vehicle propelled and/or steered by cleated belts or tracks. For purposes of this Order, a wheelchair is not considered to be a motorized wheeled vehicle.

- a. Converse Road (Forest Road No. 13S07).
- b. Camp 19 Road (Forest Road No. 13S46).
- c. Big Whistle Road (Forest Road No. 13S45).
- d. Indian Basin Road (Forest Road No. 13S48).
- e. Park Ridge Road (Forest Road No. 13S77).
- f. Park Ridge Access Road (Forest Road No. 13S77B).

36 CFR 261.54(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.


This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
