

Order No. 01-14-02
AREA CLOSURE
ANGELES NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to protect natural resources and provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Santa Clara Mojave Rivers Ranger District of the Angeles National Forest which is described in Exhibit A and shown on Exhibit B. This Order is effective from January 1, 2014, through February 28, 2014.


1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Santa Clara Mojave Rivers Ranger District, except the Elizabeth Lake Day Use Area. The closed Area is described in Exhibit A and shown on Exhibit B. 36 CFR 261.53(e).
2. Being on any National Forest System road within the Santa Clara Mojave Rivers Ranger District, which is described in Exhibit A and shown on Exhibit B. 36 CFR 261.54(e).
3. Being on any National Forest System trail within the Santa Clara Mojave Rivers Ranger District, which is described in Exhibit A and shown on Exhibit B. 36 CFR 261.55(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Owners or lessees of private land within the closed area are exempt from the prohibitions listed above to the extent necessary to gain access to their land.
3. Persons who reside on private land within the closed area are exempt from the prohibitions listed above to the extent necessary to gain access to their residences.
4. Persons with a special use permit or contract from the Forest Service authorizing work within the closed area and their employees, sub-contractors, or agents are exempt from the prohibitions listed above to the extent authorized by the special use permit or contract.
5. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions contained in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both.

Exhibit A

The Santa Clara Mojave Rivers Ranger District Closure Area begins at the intersection of Bouquet Canyon Rd. and Elizabeth Lake Rd. Township 6 N, Range 13 W, Section 17; then continues west along Lake Elizabeth Rd. to its intersection with Lake Hughes Rd. Township 7 N, Range 17 W, Section 22 and becomes Pine Canyon Rd; then continues west along Pine Canyon Rd. to its intersection with The Ridge Route, Township 8 N, 17 W, Section 32; then continues north along The Ridge Route to its intersection with CA. HWY. 138, Township 8 N, Range 18 W, Section 24; then continues west to its intersection with Interstate 5, Township 8 N, Range 18 W, Section 28; then continues south along Interstate 5 to its intersection with Templin Hwy, Township 6 N, Range 17 W, Section 33; then continues east along Templin Hwy. to Forest Rd. 6N32 (Fish Canyon) Township 6 N, Range 17 W, Section 15; then continues east along the southern edge of 6N32 to its intersection with Lake Hughes Rd. Township 6N, Range 16 W, Section 15; then continues south along Lake Hughes Rd. to its intersection with Forest Rd. 6N24 (Ruby Canyon) Township 6 N, 16 W, Section 15; then continues east along the southern edge of Forest Road 6N24 to its intersection with San Francisquito Canyon Rd. Township 6 N, 15 W, Section 22; then continues north to its intersection with Forest Rd. 6N16; then continues east and becomes Forest Rd. 6N14; then continues east along 6N14 to its intersection with Spunky Canyon Rd. Township 6 N, Range 14W, Section 20; then continues east along Spunky Canyon Rd. to its intersection with Bouquet Canyon Rd. Township 6 N, Range 14 W, Section 28; then continues east along Bouquet Canyon Rd. to its intersection with Elizabeth Lake Canyon Rd. and back to its starting point.
