



The area includes, and is accessed by, the following designated entrance points:

- Gate Access – From the West Glacier Trailhead parking area directly to Mendenhall Lake, via the Mendenhall Lake Boat Ramp (FR-84531).
- Ravine Access – From the Skater's Cabin Road shoulder directly to Mendenhall Lake, via a ten-foot wide path. The path follows a small ravine past an information board located approximately 100 yards north of Skater's Cabin.

Official ice depth measurements will be taken by US Forest Service personnel until specific conditions have been met. (see Travel Management Areas table). Results will be available at the Juneau Ranger District Office. Additional measurements will occur as weather conditions warrant.
