

Map Errata

On the Alternative maps:

- ◆ On Alternative map 1, Klakas Lakes and Streams (in the South Prince of Wales Wilderness) is a Wild River.
- ◆ On Alternative map 7, the Enacted Municipal Watershed Land Use Designation should be applied to the Ketchikan and Petersburg municipal watersheds as on Alternative 1 - 10 maps.
- ◆ On Alternative maps 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6, the area in orange on Kuiu Island just north of Alecks Lake at the head of No Name Bay should be green.
- ◆ There is no Alternative 8 map in the final environmental impact statement, therefore this map is not in the map packet.
- ◆ On Alternative map 11:
 - ◇ The eastern boundary of the small Old-Growth Habitat LUD allocation in VCU 222 is bounded by 10-Mile Creek.
 - ◇ Essowah Lakes and Streams; Gokachin, Mirror, Fish, and Low Creeks; Kegan Lake and Streams; and, Niblack Lakes and Streams, all on the Ketchikan Administrative Area, are added as Wild Rivers.
 - ◇ The southern boundary of the Timber Production LUD allocation in VCU 198 (Gallagher Creek) on Chichagof Island should be moved slightly to the south to incorporate two harvest units (Units 57 and 58) of the Humpback/Gallagher Timber Sale. The resultant change is a 160 acre reduction in the number of acres of Old-Growth Habitat LUD.

On the Resource maps:

- ◆ On the Deer Harvest by Community map there are two communities that accidentally have the same color, Port Alexander and Yakutat.

- ◆ The most correct land ownership status, as of 1996, is shown on the Forest Plan map.
