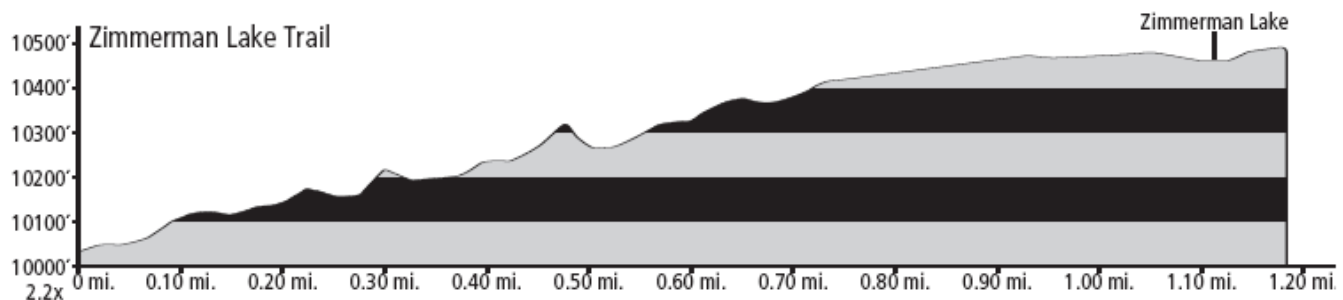
Difficulty Rating: moderate

Access: Travel 11 miles northwest of Fort Collins on U.S. Highway 287 to Colorado Highway 14. Turn left on CO 14 and travel 58 miles west to the Zimmerman Lake trailhead parking lot on the left, which is shared with visitors to the Montgomery Pass trail (#986) beginning across the road to the north.

Trail Information: The trail follows an old closed logging road up to the lake that sits just outside the boundary of the Neota Wilderness. A primitive trail circles the lake, but there are no constructed trails into the Neota Wilderness.

Trail Regulations

- No motorized equipment
- Wilderness regulations apply in the nearby Neota Wilderness
- Certified weed-free hay is required for stock
