The McCall-New Meadows Recreation Zone plans on hiring two **GS-0462-03 Forestry Aid-Trail Maintenance** positions for the 2014 field season. The duty station for these positions is located in McCall, Idaho.

The start and end date for employment is *approximately* early June through mid-August.

Government housing is not available.



These positions are in **trail maintenance** on motorized and non-motorized trails. Duties include:

- Working as a member of a two to four person crew
- Clearing trails of downfall
- Installing water diversion structures
- Rock wall construction
- Brush removal
- Tread construction and stabilization
- Bridge construction
- Proper use and care of motorized and non-motorized handtools

The crew is generally self-supporting, carrying all personal supplies and equipment in loads up to 65 pounds or more, up to 15 miles per day in remote settings. Travel is sometimes aided by the use of motorcycles. Prior motorcycle experience and a state motorcycle endorsement are preferred.

The normal work schedule is four ten hour days, followed by three days off. Crews will be expected to stay out in the field.

A valid state driver's license is required.
