Duties: The position assists with implementation of watershed restoration projects. Serves as a crew member with several others but sometimes works independently or with heavy equipment and operators. Projects include revegetation, road decommissioning, slope stabilization, erosion control, stream channel stabilization, fire rehabilitation, and watershed improvement needs surveys. This position assists with the monitoring and documentation of accomplishments of ongoing and completed projects. The position also assists with watershed inventories and provides technical support for project preparation including collection of field data which identify watershed conditions and improvement needs. The position assists in the compilation and interpretation of data collected and reporting the information.
Position Requirements: Applicants must meet one of the following to qualify for the GS-3 level: Six months of general experience of any kind that demonstrates the applicant's ability to perform the work of the position; OR experience that provided a familiarity with the subject matter or processes of the broad subject area of the occupation; OR one full year of successfully completed education above the high school level with courses related to the occupation.
