FOREST ORDER

Use of Wheeled Vehicles on Snowmobile and Ski/Snowshoe Trails

Pursuant to 36 CFR Section 261.50 (b), the following is prohibited on snowmobile and ski/snowshoe trails as depicted on the current Gallatin National Forest Over Snow Vehicle Use Map:

Using a bicycle or other wheeled vehicle between December 1st and April 15th of each year.

1. Using any type of vehicle prohibited by the order 36 CFR 261.55(b)

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this restriction:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

This Order is in effect until rescinded.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.c. 3559 and 3571).
